General Rules:

1. TDA rules apply to all MSPT tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age, have Casino's player card and valid ID to participate.
3. Ten (10) minute break at the completion of every three (3) levels. On Day 1A, play will continue until we are down to approximately 12% of the field (rounded down) or until 15 levels have been played. Day 1B will stop at exactly the same spot, in accord with the tournament clock, that Day 1A ended. Day 2 will resume at 11am combining all remaining players from 1A and 1B, and continue until a winner has been declared.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament at sole discretion without prior notice.
5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
6. \$1,100 Buy-in. Start with 15,000 chips. Optional \$10 add-on for additional 5,000 chips. Each level is forty (40) minutes. Each level for heads-up play is thirty (30) minutes.
7. \$100 of \$1,100 buy-in will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$30 of \$1,100 buy-in will be withheld for staff fee. The prize pool will consist of \$970 of every \$1,100 buy-in. \$1,500 withheld for awards, POY and championship package.
8. Late entries and a max of one (1) reentry per flight are allowed until the end of level twelve (12) and through the break. Players who bag at the end of a flight are not allowed to play a future flight unless they forfeit their stack.
9. Late entries and reentries will be dealt in immediately (do not have to wait for the blinds) and will receive a full starting stack.
10. Reentries will be assigned seat based on random draw or to balance tables at TD's discretion.
11. Ante will come from the Big Blind Only. The Big Blind is posted before the Ante.
12. There is no chopping allowed in this Main Event.

General Day 2 Rules:

1. This tournament will transition from Big Blind Ante to Standard Ante when 27 players remain to maintain fairness and integrity during short handed play when substantial pay increases exist.
2. Official MSPT percentage payouts are available for viewing at msptpoker.com.
3. Ten (10) minute break at the completion of every three (3) levels. Players will be granted a 45-minute dinner break on Day 2 when final table of 10 is reached.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament at sole discretion without prior notice.
5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
6. Players will redraw at 27 players and at the final table of 10.
7. Each level is forty (40) minutes. Each level for heads-up play is thirty (30) minutes.
8. Should multiple players bust on the bubble, prize will be awarded to the largest starting stack.
9. There is no chopping allowed in this Main Event.
