MSPT SIGNATURE SERIES RETURNS TO GOLDEN GATES CASINO FOR THE 2019 DENVER POKER OPEN, NOVEMBER 13-24

or the second time in Season 10, the MSPT is headed to Black Hawk, Colorado for the MSPT Signature Series "Denver Poker Open" November 13-24 which includes both a \$360 buy-in Regional Event boasting a \$150K Guarantee and a \$1,10 buy-in Main Event with a \$200K Guarantee.

Golden Gates Casino resides in Black Hawk, which is about an hour west of Denver. This Signature Series will include 8 total trophy events, morning and nightly cash tournaments as well as satellites into the two main events.

The first tournament of the series, the MSPT Golden Gates \$360 Regional, will feature four starting flights at Noon each day from Wednesday, November 13 through Saturday, November 16. The surviving players from each flight will then combine for Day 2 on Sunday, November 17 at 12:00 PM to play down to a winner.

The last time the MSPT visited the property for a Regional Event was back in April when Aaron Frei defeated a field of 778 entrants to earn the title and \$36,968 after a three-way chop (chops are permitted at MSPT Regional Events). Frei, Naval Subbarayan (2nd - \$30,328) and Daryl Martz (3rd - \$29,098) were the trio that chopped up the lion's share of the prize pool.

The weekend after the Regional Event, the highly-anticipated \$1,110 buy-in MSPT Main Event will kick off. That event will feature three starting flights beginning with Day 1A at Noon local time on Thursday, November 21. Days 1B and 1C will then be held at the same time on Friday, November 22 and Saturday, November 23 respectively. The remaining players from each flight will combine on Sunday, November 24 at 11:00 a.m. and play until a champion is crowned.

At the same time one year ago, the MSPT Golden Gates Denver Poker Open Main Event—the ninth ever held at the venue—drew 383 runners and saw Mike Itoafa outlast the field to earn \$81,735!

The final table will be broadcast LIVE (15-minute delay) worldwide on msptpoker.com using RFID technology allowing all viewers to see the hole cards. In addition, the entire Main Event will be live reported.

Event Preview

MSPT SEASON 10 FINALE AT CANTERBURY PARK DEC. 5-8 FEATURES \$500,000 GTD MAIN EVENT

eason 10 of the MSPT will come to a close at Minnesota's Canterbury Park, home to the first-ever MSPT event. For the second consecutive year the MSPT is ending the season with a bang by offering a \$500,000 guarantee on the \$1,100 Main Event, which will take place on Thursday, December 5 through Sunday, December 8.

The venue, which requires players be 18 years or older, will host a series of \$65 and \$250 satellites in the weeks leading up to the final Main Event of the season.

The Main Event will offer three starting flights beginning with Day 1A at 3 p.m. on Thursday, Dec. 5. Days 1B and 1C will take place at the same time on Friday, Dec. 6 and Sat. Dec. 7 respectively. The surviving players from each flight will then return at 11 a.m. on Sunday, Dec. 8 to play down to a winner.

The final table will be broadcast LIVE (15-minute delay) worldwide on msptpoker.com using RFID technology allowing all viewers to see the hole cards. In addition, the entire Main Event will be live reported in the MSPT live blog.

The MSPT has hosted 17 Main Events at Canterbury Park over the years. Most recently, Michael Esquivel topped a 472-entry field to win September's event for \$98,113 earning his first MSPT title. It was also at that stop Mark Hodge earned his way into MSPT Hall of Fame.

In last year's MSPT Season 9 finale at Canterbury Park, Andy Rubinberg prevailed over a 977-entry field to win his second MSPT title for \$179,776! In December 2018, it was Ben Marsh who emerged victorious outlasting a 493-entry field to also win his second MSPT title for \$102,493. Other MSPT Canterbury champs from the past include Mark Jaroslawski (April 2019 for \$95,700), Matt Kirby (February 2019 for \$99,573), Blake Bohn (September 2018 for \$94,568), Rob Wazwaz (April 2018 for \$109,375), Mark Collins (February 2018 for \$102,076), Carl Carodenuto (April 2016 for \$90,805 and December 2015 for \$116,103), Dan "DQ" Hendrickson (April 2015 for \$106,182), Mike Wilmes (April 2014 for \$108,984), Adam Younis (April 2013 for \$95,328), and inaugural champ John Dragich (2009 for \$34,765).

Recently, Canterbury Park unveiled a \$400-million redevelopment plan that would facilitate the development of restaurants, hotels, entertainment, offices, medical, retail and commercial recreational uses. Plans include an extended-stay hotel, boutique hotel, hotel and water park, an office space, new restaurants, specialty options, family entertain-

ment venues and more. The live part includes a luxury apartment complex, upscale townhomes, and a senior housing coop. The vision for the redevelopment is a place to "live, stay, work, play."

WINS WAY INTO MSPT HALL OF FAME

MARK HODGE WINS WAY INTO MSPT HALL OF FAME

he MSPT Hall of Fame was launched in 2017, but unlike other HoFs, there is no voting players in. Instead, there is a list of criteria players must meet in order to earn their way in. That criteria includes:

 Achieve a minimum of 25 MSPT Main Event Cashes and 1 MSPT Win OR 1 MSPT Player of the Year

OR

 Achieve a minimum of 10 MSPT Main Event Final Tables and 1 MSPT Win OR 1 MSPT Player of the Year

Thanks to his 23rd-place finish for \$3,514 in the September Canterbury Park Main Event, Mark Hodge became the fourth player to win their way into the MSPT Hall of Fame.

Over the years, Hodge has done most of his damage while living in a western suburb of Minneapolis, Minnesota, but in May of 2018 he and his wife Christine moved to Fernandina Beach, Florida, meaning he had to travel a lot further to finish off his Hall of Fame run.

Hodge's first MSPT cash came in September 2011 (Season 2) at Treasure Island Casino, placing 15th for \$2,404. He would go on to earn 24 more MSPT Main Event cashes giving him the key 25 total (4th all-time), trailing only the other three prior HOF inductees—Aaron Johnson (35), Kou Vang (32) and Rich Alsup (27). Hodge has multiple cashes in every season since Season 5.

Hodge has 5 Main Event final table appearances (7th, 10th, 4th, 6th, 4th) and \$159,832 in MSPT earnings. His best season came in 2015's Season 6 where he tallied 8 Main Event cashes, a feat that has only occurred 4 times in MSPT history. Hodge appeared at 3 final tables (2nd all-time in a season) that same year. He would go on to become the Season 6 MSPT Player of the Year.

Hodge also has 3 MSPT Regional Cashes to his name, including a 3rd place finish at Grand Casino Mille Lacs.

In addition to his MSPT success, Hodge recently placed 2nd in the CardPlayer event at BestBet Jacksonville for \$54,000. He also cashed in the 2018 – \$10,000 WSOP Main Event.

Poker pro Kou Vang—who made headlines over the summer for inciting a rant from Phil Hellmuth during the WSOP Main Event—was the first player to be inducted in 2018, while Rich Alsup and Aaron Johnson followed him.


This unique concept, combined with some of the very best corn fed beef in the country, has made Rube's a must stop for anyone visiting the Tama area.

Event Recap

ERIC "basebaldy" BALDWIN WINS HIS FIRST MSPT TITLE AT THE VENETIAN LAS VEGAS FOR \$81K

he MSPT rolled into The Venetian Las Vegas September 20-22 and after an incredible weekend, Professional Poker Player Eric Baldwin stood tall to claim MSPT Main Event 158!

In September 2018, it was 30-year old poker pro Sam Vizza, a Las Vegas grinder by way of Chicago, who emerged victorious after a five-way deal at the final table. That event attracted 315 runners.

The first two starting flights saw some incredible action, WSOP bracelet winner Jason Gooch of Vidor, TX led the way through Day 1A with 413,500 chips. Gooch had two prior MSPT cashes on his resume. Michael Ermie of Perrysburg, OH claimed the second most with 385,500. Ermie has quietly been a MSPT beast racking up thirteen MSPT main event cashes including a 3rd place finish at FireKeepers Casino in 2015 for \$48,666. Other notables to survive Day 1A were CEO of CardPlayer Magazine Barry Shulman (205,000) and Katie Lindsay (92,000). 16 of 149 entrants from 1A advanced to Sunday's Day 2.

Day 1B collected another 228 runners bringing the total to 377, up from 315 the year prior. Harold Rosenthal of Las Vegas amassed 354,000 chips to lead the way. Other notables who bagged included Eric "basebaldy" Baldwin (241,000) who final tabled this event in 2018, finishing 8th for \$8,292, Minnesota's Vic Peppe (201,000), past MSPT Champ Brian Hou (200,000), Stan Jablonski (139,000) and 2013 MSPT Player of the Year Pat Steele (136,000). 31 of 228 from 1B moved on.

46 of 377 would come back on Sunday with 45 slated to get paid. Players who came up short of making the final table but scored a cash included Patrick Steele (44th - \$2,022), Bob Shao (39th - \$2,022), Vic Peppe (38th - \$2,022), Ben Palmer (33rd - \$2,205), Katie Lindsay (32nd - \$2,205), Brian Hou (26th - \$2,573), Ting Luo (24th - \$2,977), Jim Agate (18th - \$4,043), Justin Sharpe (14th - \$4,778), Stan Jablonski (12th - \$5,881) and Michael Ermie (11th - \$5,881).

The final table got off to a slow start but eventually Card-Player Magazine CEO and two-time WSOP bracelet winner Barry Shulman was taken out when the A♠10♥ of Smith Collins caught up to Shulman's A♥K♦ as the board ran out 10♦Q♥10♠Q♠3♣ sending the poker veteran to the payout window in 10th place (\$5,881). This was Shulman's first MSPT cash

After having his stack run down, Nikhil Gera was the next to go as Mark Bloomberg took him out in 9th place (\$6,984) moving Bloomberg to just over 1.6 million. Then Gerald Cunniff started his comeback from just 70,000 chips to bounce Smith Collins in 8th place (\$9,557). Cunniff had reached the 1.4 million chip mark and with his rise saw Bloomberg's fall as Cunniff knocked him out in 7th place (\$12,130). For Minnesota's Bloomberg this was his 3rd MSPT Main Event cash and 1st final table.

Fernando Brito was another player who had battled his way back but ran into a red-hot Rudy Cadenas who hit a set of


nines to knock him out in 6th place (\$15,438). Then Richard Schneiderman battled his way off a short stack to use a pair of kings to take out Cunniff in 5th place (\$20,217) who held [Kd10c]. This was Cunniff's 6th MSPT Main Event cash and 3rd final table.

Baldwin continued to stack chips and control the table, then took out Cadenas in 4th place (\$26,833). Cadenas pushed in his last 480,000 chips and was called by Baldwin. Cadenas turned over Q46 and Baldwin showed 8C8. The board ran out J464449 KS and Cadenas was eliminated.

Baldwin struck again by eliminating Gooch in 3rd place (\$36,390). Gooch shoved all-in from the small blind for his remaining 480,000, Eric Baldwin called and rolled over $K \diamond Q \diamond$, Gooch turned up $J \diamond 6 \diamond$. The board ran out $3 \checkmark 10 \diamond 8 \diamond 3 \diamond 8 \diamond$ giving Baldwin the better flush for the win.

This set up a showdown with Schneiderman. Baldwin entered the heads-up match holding a 2-1 chip lead, though that lead did not last long. In a matter of minutes Schneiderman erased Baldwin's advantage and at one point had Baldwin down to 800,000 chips to his 6.75 million. Baldwin fought back to take a small lead once again.

Then it was fireworks. Richard Schneiderman raised to 250,000. Eric Baldwin didn't think long before moving all in, Schneiderman snap called and the cards were turned over.

Strategy presented by Jonathan Little

DON'T PLAY STRONG HANDS FOR ALL YOUR MONEY EVERY TIME

he Mid-States Poker Tour (MSPT) Grand Falls Casino \$1,100 Main Event just outside Sioux Falls, South Dakota drew 175 runners over two starting flights. Late on Day 1b flight, a big hand went down that determined the end-of-the-night chip leader.

The hand took place with just two eight-handed final tables remaining in the flight in Level 14 (1,500/3,000/3,000). It began when Eric Atchison (258,000) opened for 8,000 from the hijack and John Dennehey (233,000) three-bet to 24,000 from the button. Both blinds folded and Atchison pushed back with a four-bet to 70,000. Dennehey responded with a five-bet shove for 233,000, Atchison called, and the hands were turned up.

Dennehey: A♣A♥ Atchison: Q♣Q♠

The board ran out 7♥K♣4♣K♦8♦ and Dennehey doubled into the chip lead with the 473,500 pot while Atchison was left with just 25,000 in chips. Dennehey would go on to finish third in the tournament for \$20,190.


We consulted Jonathan Little of PokerCoaching.com about the hand.

What do you make of Dennehey's three-bet sizing in position with aces? Any argument to be made that he could've went smaller?

Little: I think the three-bet size is perfectly fine, given the deep stacks. If stacks were shallower, three-betting to a smaller size would become a better play. While I understand that it is not fun to three-bet using a "normal" size only to have your opponent fold, if you plan to three-bet with more than just the nuts, you should aim to have at least some balance in your strategy, meaning playing your best hands as you would play your worst hands, forcing your opponents into a guessing game.

Given the stack depths do you like Atchison's four-bet to 70,000 or would you have rather seen him do something different like just call?

Little: I much prefer a call, especially since they had two of the largest stacks. When you have a large stack and are facing another large stack late in a tournament, unless you have an incredibly aggressive dynamic such that you are consistently blasting large amounts of chips into the pot with wide ranges, you should strive to ensure you only play gigantic pots with a substantial advantage. While queens is certainly a strong hand, it is not so great once it becomes clear the opponent is trying to get loads of chips into the pot.

they tend to be more on the tight side. How do you feel about Atchison making the call? Could he have laid it down?

Little: Once you four-bet to 33% of your chips, the plan cannot be to fold to the all-in unless you are somehow now convinced that Dennehey's range is exactly aces or kings.

Any general words of advice for players who have difficulty playing pocket queens?

Little: Realize that you don't have to blindly blast your stack in every time you get QQ, AK, or any other strong, but non-nut hand. Many players view this hand as a standard set up, but I view it as QQ being drastically overplayed. Instead of getting all-in, Atchison should have called the three-bet, check/called the flop, probably check/called or check/folded the turn, and then certainly check/folded the river, assuming he even faced three bets. You don't have to play every seemingly strong hand for all your money every time.
