#### MSPT SIGNATURE SERIES RETURNS TO GOLDEN GATES CASINO, APRIL 13-19

or the second time in Season 10, the MSPT is headed to Black Hawk, Colorado for the back end of the MSPT Signature Series April 13-19 which includes six trophy events culminating with a \$1,110 buy-in Main Event boasting a \$200K Guarantee.

Golden Gates Casino resides in Black Hawk, which is about an hour west of Denver. Most recently, the MSPT and Golden Gates Casino partnered January 15-19 to attract the largest field in Colorado history when the \$360 buyin Regional tournament hosted 1,087 entrants. Erasmus Morfe, who also finished 19th in the 2015 World Series of Poker Main Event, cruised through most of the final day without any big swings in

either direction, eventually coming out on top.

After awarding two trophies in January, this upcoming Signature Series will include 6 more trophy events, morning and nightly cash tournaments as well as satellites into the \$200,000 guarantee main event.

The last time the MSPT visited the property for a \$1,110 Main Event was back in November when Steve Wilkie defeated a field of 399 entrants to earn the title and \$85,149. This was Wilkie's first MSPT cash at that time, just two weeks later he went on to final table and place 4th at Canterbury Park with a field of 802 runners for another \$51,944!

The highly-anticipated \$1,110 buy-in MSPT Main Event will kick off on Thursday of that week. That event will feature three starting flights beginning with Day 1A at Noon local time on Thursday, April 16. Days 1B and 1C will then be held at the same

time on Friday, April 17 and Saturday, April 18 respectively. The remaining players from each flight will combine on Sunday, April 19 at 11:00 a.m. and play until a champion is crowned.

At the same time one year ago, the eleventh Main Event ever held at the venue—drew 354 entrants and saw Brian Hou of Ann Arbor, MI outlast the field to earn \$78,973! ♥

## MSPT RETURNS TO MAJESTIC STAR CASINO WITH A \$200,000 GUARANTEED MAIN EVENT!

he MSPT is headed back to Majestic Star Casino in the East Chicagoland area (Gary, Indiana) that will culminate with a \$200,000 Guaranteed Main Event April 3-5.

A series of \$65 and \$250 satellites will kick off March 12th and feed into the \$1,100 buy-in MSPT168 Main Event, which requires players be 21+ to play. The Main Event will offer two starting flights starting with Day 1A at 3 p.m. on Friday, April 3. Day 1B will take place at the same time on Saturday, April 4. The surviving players from both flights will then return at 11 a.m. on Sunday, April 5 to play down to a winner.

Last August, the East Chicago area played host to the MSPT154 Main Event at Majestic Star Casino which turned out to be a non-stop parade of top MSPT superstars. On the final day one shone the brightest as John Sun carried the overall chip lead from Day 1 all the way to his second MSPT Main Event title, becoming the 13th player in tour history to accomplish that feat. Two starting flights attracted 324-entries, the largest major event ever held at the property. Sun walked away with \$71,945 for the win!

In January of 2019, Mike Shin of Milwaukee, WI topped a field of 309-entrants which at the time eclipsed the largest field of 301 at the property. Shin walked away with the \$68,593 top prize! The win was the second largest of Shin's career after the \$427,930 he received for finishing 12th in the 2016 WSOP Main Event. Shin would go on to win the 2019 MSPT Season 10 Player of the Year title.

"I feel awesome, man! I don't know what else to say." Shin said after his victory. "I try not to miss these events, especially in this region."

The MSPT first visited Majestic Star back in March 2014 (Season 5) when Ken Baime topped a field of 301 entrants to win the title for \$77,681. Five months later, the tour returned to the venue and saw Brian Zimcosky top a 228-entry field to win \$61.870.

Our first stop this month is at Grand Falls Casino & Golf Resort (March 4 -8). Technically in Larchwood, Iowa, but just minutes from Sioux Falls, SD. Grand Falls is far from your typical Midwest casino. From the 750 gaming options including the Motherlode slot bank, high limit lounge, and brand new Betfred Sportsbook, they will have you feeling like a Vegas high roller in no time. My restaurant recommendation is Ruthie's Steak & Seafood, but instead of heading into the dining room, pull up a seat at the bar and check out some of the best appetizers on tour. The GTO Life pick here is filet lollipops! Cooked to a perfect medium rare, the filet bites are then bacon-wrapped and drizzled with a made from scratch blue cheese demi glaze and béarnaise sauce for the win.

Beware the Ides of March, and then head to Meskwaki Casino in Tama, Iowa (March 20-22). With a massive 67,553 square feet of endless casino games including the loosest slot machines in all of Iowa, a vibrant 24/7 poker room where cash still plays at the table, and bingo every day of the week, Meskwaki is your go-to place for a good time. My personal favorite part of the casino is their incredible Winding Stream Spa. Here, you can choose from an aromatherapy wrap, a hot stone massage, a hydrating manicure and pedicure, and much more. Make sure to book your appointment in advance as openings fill up fast.

If you're looking for a quick adventure outside of the casino, the Cellar Peanut Pub tops my list. With 50 award winning craft beers on draft and some of the most knowledgeable pubtenders in the business, the Cellar Peanut Pub prides itself on not only their selection of beer but also beer education. Each pubtender is a certified beer server through the Cicerone Program, and is more than happy to chat about craft beer & peanuts. They'll even listen to a few bad beat stories if you'd like.

As we end March like a lamb and look forward to April, make sure to mark your calendars for what could be one of your last times to play at the current Majestic Star Casino, Chicago Area (April 3-5), as they prepare for a brand new land-based property. Majestic Star is made up of two boats (formerly owned by Donald Trump) floating on the great Lake Michigan. As if playing poker on a boat wasn't fun enough,

## MSPT RETURNS TO CANTERBURY PARK APRIL 24-26 FOR A \$300K GTD MAIN EVENT

innesota's Canterbury Park, home to the firstever MSPT event, plays a prominent role on the MSPT Season 11 schedule. With one Main Event at Canterbury under our belt in Season 11, in April we're returning for another \$1,100 buy-in, \$300,000 GTD Main Event, which will take place the weekend of April 24-26.

The venue, which requires players be 18 years or older, will host a series of \$65 and \$250 satellites in the weeks leading up to it. The final table will be broadcast LIVE (15-minute delay) worldwide on msptpoker.com using RFID technology allowing all viewers to see the hole cards. In addition, the entire Main Event will be live reported in the MSPT live blog.

The MSPT has hosted 23 Main Events at Canterbury Park over the years. Most recently, December's event attracted 802 entries, it was Anthony Dunne coming out on top to capture a \$155,288 first-place prize. Dunne, who doesn't have any other documented tournament cashes on HendonMob, defeated a tough final table that included three former MSPT champs, two of which were also former Players of the Year. Still, Dunne outlasted them all to claim the title and six-figure score.

One year ago in April, Minnesota's Canterbury Park attracted 450 entries and after a full weekend of play, Mark Jaroslawski of Stillwater, Minnesota, navigated a grueling MSPT Canterbury Park this weekend, shipping the title and \$95,700 after a five-and-a-half hour battle at the final table. His unorthodox style of making large bet sizes preflop worked to his advantage, and he explained them by saying, "I like to play big pots, I like to mix it up, catch somebody off guard. My motto was 'No free cards anymore,' because Day 1 on Friday, I lost six pots early, all because I got rivered because I let them get there. I decided after that, just hammer down." For Jaroslawski, it was his 4th MSPT Main Event cash and 1st Final Table.

Other MSPT Canterbury champs from the past include Michael Esquivel (September 2019 for \$98,113), Matt Kirby (February 2019 for \$99,573), Andrew Rubinberg (December 2018 for \$179,776), Ben Marsh (December 2017 for \$102,493), Blake Bohn (September 2018 for \$94,568), Rob Wazwaz (April 2018 for \$109,375), Mark Collins (February 2018 for \$102,076), Carl Carodenuto (April 2016 for \$90,805 and December 2015 for \$116,103), Dan "DQ" Hendrickson (April 2015 for \$106,182),

Mike Wilmes (April 2014 for \$108,984), Adam Younis (April 2013 for \$95,328), and inaugural champ John Dragich (2009 for \$34,765).

Recently, Canterbury Park renovated their card room, gaming pits, restaurant options and entrance to the Track Level. In addition, Canterbury unveiled a \$400-million redevelopment plan that would facilitate the development of restaurants, hotels, entertainment, offices, medical, retail and commercial recreational uses. Plans include an extended-stay hotel, boutique hotel, hotel and water park, an office space, new restaurants, specialty options, family entertainment venues and more. The live part includes a luxury apartment complex, upscale townhomes and a senior housing co-op. The vision for the redevelopment is a place to "live, stay, work, play."

Canterbury Park Racetrack and Card Casino is Minnesota's only thoroughbred and quarter horse racing facility. There is also year-round wagering on simulcast horse racing and hosts a variety of other entertainment and special events at its facility.

## PATRICK STEELE WINS WAY INTO MSPT HALL OF FAME

he MSPT Hall of Fame was launched in 2017, but unlike other HoFs, there is no voting players in. Instead, there is a list of criteria players must meet in order to earn their way in. That criteria includes:

 Achieve a minimum of 25 MSPT Main Event Cashes and 1 MSPT Win OR 1 MSPT Player of the Year

OR

 Achieve a minimum of 10 MSPT Main Event Final Tables and 1 MSPT Win OR 1 MSPT Player of the Year

As highlighted in the February issue of MSPT Magazine, Sunday, January 19th was a big day for Chelsea, Michigan's Patrick Steele. Not only did he best a 611-entry field at JACK Cleveland Casino in Ohio to win the 2020 Cleveland Poker Open \$1,100 Main Event for \$124,461, Steele also became just the fifth person in tour history to earn a spot in the MSPT Hall of Fame.

That win was Steele's 25th MSPT Main Event cash (5th all-time) and he has 5 MSPT Main Event Top Tens (4th, 3rd, 4th, 10th, 1st) totaling \$273,912 in MSPT earnings.


Steele talked about his historic night after his win: "Words can't describe it, but to do two things in one night, finally get a win on the MSPT, it's pretty awesome. To be involved with the great Hall of Famers, it's cool to be a part of both of those groups."

Steele also won the MSPT Season 4 Player of the Year title – not to mention amassing nearly \$600,000 in lifetime earnings according to The Hendon Mob including a \$155,636 win on the Heartland Poker Tour.

Steele, who attended Northwood University in Midland, Michigan where he played Division II football, owns Steele Heating & Cooling, Inc.—a third-generation family business—but has been supplementing his income through poker.

Steele's first MSPT cash came in March 2013 (Season 4) at FireKeepers Casino in Battle Creek, MI, placing 4th for \$18,364. Just two weeks later he would go on to place 3rd at Ho-Chunk Gaming WI Dells for \$27,772. He then final tabled again in August 2013 placing 4th for \$18,880. Steele would appear in the Top Ten 4 times in Season 4—still a tour record—earning Player of the Year honors.

Steele has racked up 25 main event cashes giving him the key HoF total number, tying him with HoF'er Mark Hodge

and trailing only the three prior HoF inductees—Aaron Johnson (38), Kou Vang (32) and Rich Alsup (29). Steele racked up 7 cashes in Season 10 alone. He has cashed at least once in every season since his first score in Season 4, eight consecutive years.

In addition to his MSPT success, Steele placed 332nd in the 2018 WSOP \$10K Championship for \$37,705, 22nd place in the 2015 WSOP \$1,500 Millionaire Maker for \$45,275 and 362nd in the 2013 WSOP \$10K Championship for \$28,063.

## BOB WHALEN WINS MSPT THE VENETIAN LAS VEGAS POKER BOWL IV

he fourth edition of the MSPT \$1,100 buy-in Poker Bowl at The Venetian Las Vegas featured a \$1 MILLION guarantee, and a massive turnout of 1,093 entries resulted in a \$1,060,210 prize pool.

On Saturday night, the day before the NFL Super Bowl LIV between the San Francisco 49ers and Kansas City Chiefs, a winner was crowned in the MSPT Poker Bowl IV after Bob Whalen of Henderson, NV began as the Day 2 chip leader and

rode it to victory after a five-way deal was struck.

Whalen took \$140,152 as a part of that deal, which was a new career-high surpassing the \$129,967 he previously won back in 2009 after taking down a Heartland Poker Tour (HPT) Main Event. In 2008, he also finished 79th in the World Series of Poker Main Event for \$77,200. This was Whalen's first MSPT cash.

Whalen, formerly from Wisconsin, has lived in Vegas for

the past three and a half years playing about town nearly every day of the week. However, it wasn't his first taste of victory at The Venetian as ten years ago he won three Deep-Stack tournaments within a two-week span.

Among those to make the money at the top 150 were Terry Fleischer (14th - \$11,662), Marko Pantelic (20th - \$8,588), Poker Bowl II champ Kfir Nahum (22nd - \$7,209), Kathy Liebert (23rd - \$7,209), Sorel Mizzi (31st - \$4,559), Brett Halan (41st - \$3,499), Ashley Sleeth (47th - \$3,181), Kenna James (60th - \$2,863), Chipp Jett (66th - \$2,757), Eric Wasylenko (70th - \$2,757), and MSPT Season 1 Running Aces champ Joe Matheson (77th - \$2,651).

#### **Final Table Action**

MSPT regular Kou Yang was the first final table casualty after running pocket fours into Justin Young's sixes, and Eyal Al Revah followed him out the door after committing his short stack with king-ten suited only to see Grachia Minasian roll over pocket aces. Revah flopped a flush draw but bricked the turn and river to fall in ninth place.

The short-stacked Vadim Shlez was next to go after losing king-ten to Young's ace-queen all in preflop, while Young himself bowed out in seventh running pocket tens into George Brady's two black jacks.

Next on the chopping block was John Dennehey, who lost

holding jacks to Minasian's ace-nine after the latter made a straight on the river. At that point, the final five players paused the clock to discuss a deal. They came to terms, and as the chip leader, Whalen was crowned the Poker Bowl IV MVP taking down his first MSPT title.
